Art

Active experiences in drawing, painting, designing and sculpting as well as working in clay, paper and fibers are designed to develop visual, spatial and manipulative skills.

Ballet

These classes will introduce your child to the basic Ballet vocabulary as well as the French terms used in a structured yet fun setting. Simple coordination, balance, strength exercises for the core, musicality, rhythm and concentration are emphasized. Students are encouraged to explore space and enjoy dancing and interacting.

Cooking and Etiquette

This is a hands-on cooking class designed to engage children while introducing them to different colors, tastes, textures and smells in the kitchen. Recipes will be simple and fun while focusing on basic skills. In addition, each class will incorporate core kitchen concepts such as kitchen safety, food safety, etiquette and table setting.

Dinosaur Discoveries

This dinosaur-based program is the ideal for your curious, dinosaur-loving explorer. We will learn those oh-so exciting dinosaur names, learn about how they moved, what they ate, and have the chance to go digging for dinosaur fossils like a real paleontologist!
